## EXPECTATIONS OF STUDENTS ATTENDING SUPER SUMMER

Super Summer exists to inspire and equip students as Kingdom-minded leaders. Our goal for students participating in Super Summer is that they would come away better prepared to lead, primarily in the setting of the local church (Ephesians 4:11-14). It is not expected that every student attend Super Summer. Also, past attendance at Super Summer does not necessarily mean that a student is ready to attend again. This will be evaluated yearly when Super Summer registration is taking place, through the application and interview process.

The following guidelines are from the Letter to Pastors, from the Super Summer Board of Directors:

***During the required interview process (conducted by the Youth Pastor or Leader), the following criteria should be taken into consideration. (The student):***

- 1. Has made a commitment to follow Jesus.*
- 2. Has an active devotional life.*
- 3. Regularly attends and supports youth ministry events at their home church.*
- 4. Is an active leader in their total student ministry.*
- 5. Has a positive witness/testimony outside of church and with their family.*
- 6. Expresses a willingness to share their faith with their peers.*

These six criteria will be used to determine who demonstrates a readiness for Super Summer and what it offers and requires.

Leadership also requires presence; you simply cannot be a leader where you are not actively and consistently involved. In order to go to Super Summer, there will be a requirement of at least 50% attendance at Youth services; for this reason, it will be important for you to check in at the Youth Building when you arrive. It is also expected that Super Summer attendees will regularly attend EHC on Sunday mornings.
